## "VARONES HERMANOS, ¿QUÉ HAREMOS?"

"Men and brethren, what shall we do?" Were the question posed in Acts 2:37 asked of us, answering it would not present a problem for members of the Lord's church here at Independence. We might simply point to the next verse in which Peter told those present on Pentecost to "repent and be baptized" for the remission of their sins (Acts 2:38). If we were asked this by a growing number of our neighbors, it would not be so easy to answer. The reason is that they were they to ask the question of Acts 2:37, it would look and sounds like the words of the title above.

These neighbors speak Spanish, and, often, little or no English!

How do we answer that question if they ask? Do we bother? Maybe, we might reason, someone else will answer the question for them. Brethren, the Lord requires that we answer their question! It is imperative that we bother, because if we do not, who will? If we do not answer their question, the answer that they might receive to that question-- if they receive one at all--would almost certainly come from someone who does not know the church of the Bible.

Can we answer that question? Yes! Unfortunately, though, we cannot answer that question doing what we are doing. We must do more. We must provide an avenue through which these may be taught the Gospel in their native tongue. For this reason, the elders of the church here in Independence have determined to start a Hispanic congregation. This effort will not be free, and it will not be easy; however, if the Gospel can be preached to this growing segment of our community, then the plea of Matthew 28:19 and Mark 16:15 will be answered with regard to these, our neighbors.

*This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you... (1 John 1:5).*

In considering the need for such a work, the elders learned that there are 2,272 Hispanic homes within a 20-mile radius of our building. The nearest Hispanic congregation is at the Getwell Church of Christ in Memphis, which is 26.8 miles from here (by road) and, therefore, over 40 miles away (as the crow flies) from some whom we might reach. What we have open before is a great door of opportunity; moreover, with the Lord's aid we have the ability to go through that door. Someone wisely said that where there are opportunity and ability, there is responsibility.

Today is the day that we begin to meet this challenge! The elders have decided that anything given above \$1,000.00 today (that is roughly the amount of the weekly expense that the congregation has--taking into account salary, insurance, an MSOP student, our overseas mission works, and electricity, etc.) will be put toward the Hispanic work. What the Hispanic work needs to get off the ground is as follows:

- About \$1229.00: Direct mail of a 4.25" x 6" postcard to every Hispanic home within the 20 mile radius
- \$50.00: 50 copies of the Spanish version of the *Searching for Truth* DVD, *Buscando la Verdad*
- \$Perhaps already paid for: 24"x30" sign to make people aware of the service times for the Hispanic congregation--this sign will match the sign to the left of the front door and will be placed opposite it
- \$?: Songbooks and Bibles (we are hoping to receive a donation from the work at Getwell which would include used books and some tracts [the latter we will distribute with other information at Trade Days])
- \$?: Remuneration for a preacher who speaks Spanish; this would be tantamount to having a preacher student like Rafael Ramirez come down weekly
- \$Already paid for: Business cards promoting the Hispanic work (to be distributed at Trade Days, etc.)
- \$Already paid for: A page on our church website

Brethren, what this means is that we need at least \$1,300.00 to begin this work--\$13,000 would be even better. While that may seem like a lot, we must not let that be an obstacle (Matthew 16:26); that is a far cry less than what Jesus has already paid for it (Acts 20:28)! The elders know, and appreciate, the sacrifices that are made by many of this number; we also know that we, as the Lord's people, must utilize every avenue we may to reach any who are lost! Please prayerfully consider this work, and do what you can to help us to get it off of the ground.

“Last month, my wife and I had the privilege of being part of a week campaign to the city of Palenque, in the state of Chiapas, southern Mexico. There was no congregation of the Lord’s church in Palenque until this year. They started in January and they have so far about ten in membership, a good number of visitors and a lot of children. There was a great need in this city for the Gospel of Christ to be preached, and there was a family who saw this need and decided to start this work in Palenque. Their names are Domingo and Gloria. **They first heard the Gospel, not in Palenque but in Mississippi, in the city of Tupelo!** (Emphasis-DFC). Although there is no Spanish-speaking congregation in Tupelo, Domingo and Gloria were reached by an English-speaking one.

“By using this example, I want to point out that there is a great need for reaching the Hispanics in the United States; their population is growing, and new generations are coming. I’m convinced that if one family was able to hear the Gospel in English, no doubt many more would be able to hear it if it is taught to them in their mother tongue. There are many honest and good hearts among them that need to be found. I am excited about this opportunity, and pray that God will bless his work among the Hispanics and that we will take every opportunity to be part of it.”
